Reviewer's Comments: The 2023 The Cure is a blend of 45% Syrah, 30% Grenache, and 25% Mourvèdre. It was aged for 20 months in French oak, 45% new. It races out with exuberant notes of red currant jelly, black cherries, and black raspberries, followed by hints of wild sage, underbrush, and black pepper with a touch of anise. Full-bodied, the palate is stacked with red and black berry layers, supported by firm, grainy tannins and bold freshness, finishing long and spicy. Yum!
