Reviewer's Comments: The 2023 The Story is made from 100% Grenache, aged for 20 months in 38% new French oak and the rest in concrete. Pale to medium ruby-purple colored, it rolls out with fragrant notes of kirsch and black raspberries, plus hints of black pepper, garrigue, and orange peel. Full-bodied, the palate delivers mouth-coating, pure, bright red berry flavors with a grainy texture and plenty of freshness, finishing long and perfumed.
