Reviewer's Comments: The 2023 The Source is 100% Syrah, aged for 20 months in French oak, 60% new. Deep garnet-purple in color, it needs a little swirling to bring out notes of juicy black plums and ripe raspberries, plus hints of tapenade, tar, lilacs, and underbrush. The rich, concentrated, full-bodied palate is packed with black and red berry layers, supported by firm, velvety tannins and bags of freshness, finishing long and peppery.
